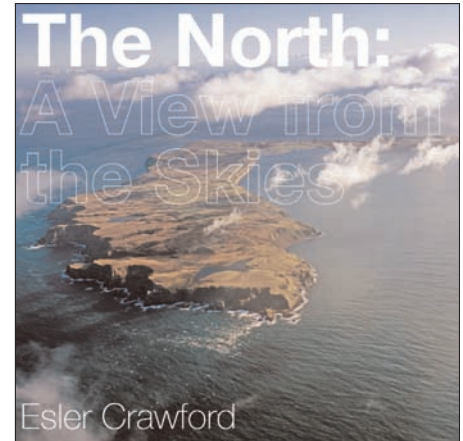
## A View from the Skies
